



Our manufacturing techniques give us a set of characteristics that are commonly unfamiliar to buyers.

Because of this unfamiliarity, many times customers, builders, and masons react negatively to these characteristics and wrongly pass off our brick as defective.

Below we will explain the variation that is to be expected with size and color.



VARIATION IN SIZE

As a consequence of our handcrafting and use of older technology kilns, we will always have slight variations in size.

Between the smallest and largest brick in your order, there can be up to a 1/2" difference.

If your mason uses the recommended mortar joint size of 5/8", there will be no issues of unevenness with your brick wall, as the joint will absorb any differences in size.

VARIATION IN COLOR & TEXTURE

Like all of our processes, brick decoration is done by hand. Due to this, it is expected for our brick to have differences in color and texture from brick to brick.

Upon receiving your brick there will likely be slight differences of color, tone, and texture when compared to samples or photographs online. This does not constitute a defect and is to be expected.
